

**Ending of Staged Customs Controls
HMRC / Border Force inspection locations in
Great Britain for arrivals from Dutch ports**



Immingham

Imports (customs inspections and additional customs endorsements, such as T1 or Carnet stamping):

- Prior to exiting **Port of Immingham**, driver / collecting driver must check GMR inspection status on GVMS Inspection Lookup Service (ILS)*
- If notified of an inspection, or if additional customs endorsements are required, driver to report immediately to Immingham BCP
- Goods remain under Customs control and drivers are responsible for ensuring that goods are taken directly to the facility and presented in the same condition as at time of importation

Exports (LRN/MRN (T1) Process)

- Port of Immingham is an Arrived Exports location
 - Prior to checking in at **Stena Line, Immingham** - driver / delivering driver must check status of unit
 - If notified of an inspection, or if additional customs endorsements are required, driver must report to Immingham BCP BEFORE reporting for check in.
 - For all export LRN/MRN (T1) documentation this is now required to be authorised by Border force at the new Border Control Post shown on the map
- On arrival at BCP please proceed to entry gate and notify the team you need LRN authorising to a T1 MRN document. You will be guided to a parking bay and escorted to Border Force for them to complete the process, once complete you can carry on to Stena check in as normal
