

SHADOW UK ETS MATRIX LEVELS

March 2026



We are launching a shadow ETS for UK domestic routes, which will be applicable 1st of July 2026 to give you an indication regarding what the ETS surcharges might become. The calculated shadow ETS is the rate you would have received based on current assumptions if effective today.

Routes and invoicing currency, per metre

Adjustment rules 2026:

1. The surcharge will be adjusted on a monthly basis and will be valid for one calendar month.
2. The surcharge will be calculated based upon a one month average GBP per metric tonne price for CO² emission price* as of Bloomberg, www.bloomberg.com. The conversion rate will be the average for the same one month period, as quoted by the Swedish National Bank*.
3. The adjustments will take place on the 1st of each month.
4. UK domestic routes will be covered 50%

* To facilitate introduction of new ETS rates on 1st of each month, the calculation is based on the average GBP per metric tonne price for CO² and GBP rate of exchange up to the 21st of the previous month (e.g. May based on 22nd March to 21st April).

WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR EACH ROUTE?

Stena Line's ships will be affected with payment obligations. What the rate will be depends on the route.

-  100% of emission from intra-European routes
-  50% of emission from extra-European routes
-  50% of emissions from UK domestic routes starting 1 July 2026
